

Notice of Vote on a Question and Requirements for Voter Identification

*Local Authorities Election Act
(Sections 7, 12, 35, 46, 53)*

LOCAL JURISDICTION: **WESTLOCK COUNTY**, PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

Notice is hereby given that a Vote on a Question to the electors of Westlock County has been approved by the Council of Westlock County for the 2017 General Municipal Election. The Question that will appear on the ballot is as follows:

“Knowing the operating cost impact of the Tawatinaw Valley Ski Hill on the annual operating budget, are you in favour of selling the Tawatinaw Ski Hill Facility regardless of whether it remains a ski hill or is used for different purposes? ___ Yes ___ No ”

Voting on the Question will take place on the 16th day of October 2017, between the hours of 10: a.m. and 8:00 p.m., local time. Voting stations will be located at:

- Division 1: Vimy Community Hall
- Division 2: Busby Community Hall
- Division 3: Pembina Heights Hall
- Division 4: Westlock Royal Canadian Legion
- Division 5: Clyde Community Hall
- Division 6: Dapp Community Hall
- Division 7: Jarvie Community Center (former school)

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must contain your name and address (nearby P.O. Box is acceptable) and must be one of the following:

- (i) Photo identification issued by a Canadian government or agency, whether federal, provincial or local;
- (ii) Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque; (iii) Correspondence issued by a school, college or university; (iv) Government cheque or cheque stub; (v) Income/property tax assessment notice; (vi) Insurance policy or coverage card; (vii) Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee; (viii) Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation; (ix) Residential lease or mortgage statement; (x) Statement of government benefits: e.g. Employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support, or child tax benefit; (xi) Utility bill: e.g. Telephone, public utilities commission, television, electricity, gas or water; (xii) Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate; or, (xiii) A letter or form (attestation) confirming that the person lives at the stated address. The letter can be signed by any of the following: authorized representative of a commercial property management company; authorized representative of a correctional institution; authorized representative of a First Nations band or reserve; authorized representative of a post-secondary institution; authorized representative of a facility that provides services to the homeless; or authorized representative of a supportive living facility or treatment centre.
