Council accepts Follow-up Action Report

Council accepted the Council Resolution Follow-up action report as information.

Policy No. 1202-007 Sale of Properties approved.

Council approved the proposed changes to the Sale of Properties Policy No 1202-007.

Bylaw 75-2025 Amendments to Fees, Rates and Charges Bylaw 51-2023 received third reading

At the November 10, 2025, Regular Meeting of Council, Council gave third reading and passed Bylaw 75-2025 Amendments to Fees, Rates and Charges Bylaw 51-2025.

Council accepts Community Grant Committee Recommendations

Council approved awarding \$14,350.00 in community grant funding to the Vimy & District Lions Club, Busby Community League, Fawcett Seniors Citizens Club, Water's Edge Camping Society, Jarvie Community Council, and Westlock & District Agricultural Society. The Jarvie Community Council requested to reallocate grant funding from 2024 to pay operational expenses, which Council approved.

Council accepts ACP Grant Partnership with the Village of Clyde

Council approved Westlock County's participation as the managing partner in an Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) – Intermunicipal Collaboration grant application, in partnership with the Village of Clyde. This provided a joint purpose of GIS mapping project to document and integrate Clyde's municipal infrastructure data to support regional planning and emergency management. Council also authorized the Chief Administrative Officer to execute all necessary agreements and documentation to complete the grant submission.
