- Add applicable Safety Codes Council levy to each permit; \$4.50 or 4.0% of the permit fee **whichever is greater**.
- A minimum cancellation fee of **25%** or **\$35.00** (whichever is greater) will be retained when a permit is cancelled. No fee is returned when an inspection has been carried out.
- Permit extensions will be charged at a flat rate of \$150.00 (plus levy) for a maximum of 1 year
- Re-inspection fees will be charged at a rate of \$150 (plus levy)
- Re-opening a previously closed permit fee will be charged at \$75.00 (plus levy)
- Variances will be charged at a rate of \$120/hour (min 2 hr) (plus levy).

If construction has started prior to the approval of the Development Application and Safety Code Permit Application, Permit fees will be doubled per Westlock County's Fees, Rates, and Charges Bylaw No. 51-2023
