## DOG OVER-LIMIT PERMITS

- 1. Notwithstanding Section 7 of the Responsible Dog Ownership Bylaw, Westlock County may issue to an Owner a Dog Over-Limit Permit.
- 2. Any owner wishing to obtain a Dog Over-Limit permit must complete an Over-Limit Application form and submit the completed application form with the fee, to Westlock County.
- 3. As part of the Application Process, an owner wishing to obtain a Dog Over-Limit Permit may be requested to obtain written consent from those individuals residing immediately adjacent to the property of the dog owner.
- 4. Upon receipt of a completed application form, Westlock County Enforcement Services shall consider the application and may, in sole and absolute discretion:
  - a. Refuse to grant the over-limit permit
  - b. Grant an over-limit permit
  - c. Grant an over-limit permit upon such additional terms and conditions as deemed appropriate
- 5. An over-limit permit shall not be transferrable
- 6. Westlock County Enforcement Services may revoke or amend permits if:
  - a. The conditions of the permit have been breached; or
  - b. Complaints received; or
  - c. The permit holder harbors dogs in excess of the number permitted, the number of dogs must reflect over-limit permit(s)
- 7. If Westlock County Enforcement Services revokes an over-limit permit, no refund of the permit application shall be made.
