### WESTLOCK COUNTY Intersectional Signs

In order to assist the public in general, with understanding the County's Intersectional Signing Program, the following explanation is provided:

Township Roads (TWP RD) (Roads running East/West) increase in number from south to north.  
Range Roads (RGE RD) (Roads running South/North) increase in number from east to west.

The first two numbers of an East/West road will describe the TWP in which the road is located, the last number will indicate how far north the road is within that TWP.  
Example:  
The most southerly road in TWP 60 will be numbered TWP RD 600, the next road, two (2) miles north of TWP RD 600, will be TWP RD 602, etc.

The first two numbers of a South/North road will describe the RGE in which the road is located (except those roads West of the 5th Meridian - where only the first number will describe the RGE), the last number will indicate how far west the road is within that RGE.  
Examples:  
The farthest east road in RGE 26 will be numbered RGE RD 260, the next road, one (1) mile west of RGE RD 260, will be RGE RD 261, etc.  
The farthest east road in RGE 1 will be RGE RD 10 (the 5th Meridian), the next road one (1) mile west will be RGE RD 11, etc.

It should be noted that the many forced roads in between may have a combination of numbers and letters, but generally, fall within the numbering system described herein. If anyone has a specific question, or concern about the signing program, please call the County office at 780-349-3346.
