



WESTLOCK COUNTY BY-LAW 27-2021

WESTLOCK, ALBERTA

Being a bylaw of Westlock County, in the Province of Alberta, to establish fees, rates and charges for services rendered by Westlock County.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, and amendments thereto, Council may pass a bylaw respecting the fees, rates and charges for goods and services provided by or on behalf of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, and amendments thereto, a municipality has the power to enact bylaws for the purpose of operating a public utility.

AND WHEREAS, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, and amendments thereto, a municipality has the power to enact for the enforcement of bylaws including the imposition of fines and penalties.

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and amendments thereto, a municipality must make certain information available to the public and that Council may pass a bylaw to establish fees for the provision of such information.

AND WHEREAS, Council of Westlock County deems it desirable and fiscally responsible to establish fees, rates and charges for municipal services and the use of municipal facilities.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF WESTLOCK COUNTY, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1.0 Title

1.1 This bylaw is cited as the "Fees, Rates and Charges Bylaw".

2.0 Purpose

2.1 The purpose of this bylaw is to establish fees, rates, and charges for services rendered by Westlock County into a single publication for the convenience of residents of the Municipality of Westlock County.


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3.0 Definitions

- 3.1 **Act** means the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, and amendments thereto, hereinafter referred to as the *MGA*
- 3.2 **CAO** means the Chief Administrative Officer of Westlock County.
- 3.3 **FOIP** means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

4.0 Preamble and Schedules

- 4.1 The fees, rates and charges contained in the attached Schedules are hereby established and are subject to applicable taxes where appropriate, unless otherwise noted.
- 4.2 Where this bylaw establishes a fee that also exists in another bylaw or policy that predates the effective date of this bylaw, the fee(s) in this bylaw shall be the applicable fee and the other bylaw or policy is hereby effectively amended.
- 4.3 The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to consolidate bylaws and policies to reflect the fees, rates and charges established and amended by this bylaw.

5.0 Review

- 5.1 This Bylaw and the Schedules contained therein, shall be brought forward for review annually, and/or when relevant legislation is amended, and at any other time that Council deems appropriate to ensure that it remains current and continues to accurately reflect the fees, rates, and charges.
- 5.2 Some rates will increase more than annually. The rate set by the governing body or legislation will be the rate charged, regardless of whether it is reflected in this Bylaw.


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6.0 Provision Statement

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6.1 Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of all other provisions. If any such provision of this Bylaw is declared invalid for any reason by a court of jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw shall remain valid and enforceable.

This bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.



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
